**Syed Kazmi, MD**  
 Dr. Syed Kazmi is a rehabilitation specialist who currently practices in Round Rock Texas as the Medical Director of the Stroke and Brain Injury program. He is also an Assistant Professor at Tufts University School of Medicine in Boston. He received his medical training and General Medicine/ Surgery internship in Pakistan and his Internal Medicine Internship at Bridgeport Hospital- Yale School of Medicine in New Haven, Connecticut. He was a Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation Resident at Tufts University- New England Medical Center in Boston. He has given presentations on a variety of Neurological Rehabilitation topics.

**Rhett Murray, MD, F.A.C.S.**  
 Dr. Murray specializes in the treatment of spinal, cranial and peripheral nerve disorders.
