What is the PSB- Health Occupations Aptitude Examination?

The PSB-Health Occupations Aptitude Examination is a reliable predictor of your potential success in the program.

The PSB exam is specifically designed for healthcare programs. It is composed of five parts that will be evaluated by multiple choice questions administered in a three hour computer based session. The test measures an applicant's ability, skill, knowledge, and attitude for performance in the health care environment. Areas of emphasis include academic aptitude (vocabulary & arithmetic), spelling, reading comprehension, natural sciences, and a vocational adjustment index. It is used to determine an applicant's readiness for entry into the program.

Who must take the PSB Exam?

All candidates applying for admission to the program are required to take the PSB exam.

How does an applicant register to take the PSB Exam?

The program will contact applicants starting in January up to early March to schedule a date to take the PSB exam.
