



Got COVID-19?

If you recently tested positive for COVID-19 and have pre-existing health issues, Huntsville Hospital Fever & Flu Clinic may be able to stop your illness from becoming severe.

We offer monoclonal antibody IV therapy – a one-time treatment approved for emergency use by the U.S. Food & Drug Administration that can slow the progression of COVID-19 symptoms if given early in the course of the disease.

Monoclonal antibodies are most effective in patients who are at high risk for hospitalization due to:

- Older age
- Overweight (BMI > 25)
- Chronic kidney disease
- Diabetes
- Immunosuppressive disease or immunosuppressive treatment
- Cardiovascular disease (including congenital heart disease)
- Hypertension
- Chronic lung disease
- Sickle cell disease
- Neurodevelopmental disorders
- Medical-related technological dependence (such as CPAP, tracheostomy, gastrostomy)
- Other medical conditions that may place a patient at high risk for progression to severe COVID-19

If you recently tested positive for COVID-19, call (256) 265-1498 today to see if you are a candidate for monoclonal antibody infusion therapy. Treatments are offered Monday - Friday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. and are covered by most health insurance plans.
