

## Preparing for Your Immigration Physical

Immigration physicals are done in a series of 2-3 appointments. The sequential nature of these visits align with established protocols and regulatory requirements, aimed at ensuring the accuracy and completeness of your immigration medical examination.

- During the initial visit, we review immunization records and give the Flu/TDap/ 1<sup>st</sup> Polio vaccines if needed. Polio is a 3 part series, it is important to have this documentation in the immunization record if received in the past. We draw titers to assess immunity to MMR/Varicella/Hep B. We draw blood for a T-spot and collect urine for gonorrhea testing. The collection of the samples is essential to ensure compliance with immigration health requirements.
- Subsequently, during the second visit, in adherence to USCIS guidelines we gather a complete medical history. We draw the syphilis blood test. We administer necessary vaccines based on titer results. If the T-spot is positive, a chest x-ray will be performed. The immigrant will see the Civil Surgeon for their physical.
- Lastly, when syphilis results are received, OHG will finalize form i-693 with the appropriate test results. OHG will put together a sealed packet for the immigration interview and also supply the patient with a copy for their records. The immigrant will be contacted by phone when their packets are ready for pick up.

We appreciate your understanding of these protocols and regret any inconvenience caused by the multiple appointments.
