ENT HOSPITALIST

This unique opportunity for an ENT hospitalist is a new position and will serve Huntsville Hospital and its affiliated regional hospitals. Responsibilities will include inpatient consult coverage, Emergency Room consultations for unattached patients, and assisting the 13 community-based otolaryngologists. Call will be shared with community-based physicians. Hospitalist will have post-discharge follow-up clinic and the full support of the Huntsville Hospital Physicians Network. Current staff Otolaryngologist can be available to discuss additional details.

Candidate must be proficient with all aspects of Otolaryngology including general, pediatric, facial trauma and emergent airway. This position may be well-suited for recent graduate of an accredited residency program or an experienced physician interested in less administrative/management responsibility.

Huntsville Hospital is a 971-bed hospital that serves as the regional referral center for North Alabama and southern Tennessee. Our Emergency Departments treat approximately 160,000 patients per year. The hospital has 24/7 Hospitalist, Radiology, Cardiology, Orthopedic, Trauma and Neurosurgical coverage. The hospital also has dedicated Adult, Cardiovascular, Neurological, Surgical/Trauma and Pediatric ICUs. The hospital has been designated as one of three Level I trauma centers in the state.
