Established Gastroenterology practice seeks additional physicians to join their group. There are six physicians currently, each of whom see 15-25 patients per day. The practice offers all approved gastroenterological procedures including colonoscopy and EGD.



The practice's primary clinic is located in a medical professional tower attached to the hospital. Two other locations serve patients in western Madison County and Northwest Alabama. Our 37 full time employees include an on-site office manager, receptionist, RNs and four Nurse Practitioners in the hospital. More 1,200 procedures are performed per month in the state of the art Endoscopy Lab.

With 941 licensed beds, Huntsville Hospital is a community-based, not-for-profit institution, and is the state's second largest hospital. Huntsville Hospital Health System, the nation's third largest publicly owned hospital system, is a teaching facility for the University of Alabama-Birmingham's School of Medicine.
