PEDIATRIC HEMATOLOGIST/ONCOLOGIST

Huntsville Hospital for Women & Children, in conjunction with St. Jude Children's Research Hospital, seeks a qualified Pediatric Hematologist/Oncologist. The St. Jude Affiliate Program's mission is to extend care and benefits to more children and increase the number of children enrolled in St. Jude clinical trials. The physicians and staff at these sites work in collaboration with St. Jude staff to deliver protocol-based care to pediatric hematology and oncology patients. The team at the St. Jude Huntsville affiliate clinic is a part of Huntsville Hospital for Women & Children and works with St. Jude as a partner in the care of children with cancer and blood diseases.

We are committed to the addition of a full-time Pediatric Hematologist/Oncologist whose professional, social and economic interests would lend themselves to a long-term cultural fit within the St. Jude Huntsville affiliate clinic and the community. The candidate will perform routine and customary care of inpatient and outpatient pediatric hematology/oncology patients and should expect a clinical practice that consists of approximately 60 percent general hematology cases and 40 percent general oncology cases. The candidate must be BC/BE in Pediatric Hematology/Oncology.

Our growing clinic currently sees 35-45 new oncology patients per year. Opportunities for education of medical students and participation in clinical research are available through our collaboration with St. Jude. The physician will join one full-time and two part-time Pediatric Hematologist/Oncologists, in addition to two nurse practitioners who function as physician extenders.
